Subject:	Proposal for transfer of appropriations No 8/2015 within Section IV - Court of Justice - of the general budget for 2015

On 20 November 2015, the Court of Justice submitted to the Council its proposal for transfer 1. of appropriations No 8/2015.

The purpose of this proposal is to transfer a total amount of EUR 1 480 000 to Item 2 0 0 0 (Rent), of which EUR 700 000 from Item 1 0 0 2 (Entitlements on entering the service, transfer and leaving the service), EUR 550 000 from Item 1 2 0 4 (Entitlements related to entering the service, transfer and leaving the service) and EUR 230 000 from Item 1 2 2 0 (Allowances for staff retired in the interests of the service).

2. The transfer is being proposed to cover the additional needs in 2016 resulting from the gap between the estimated and the final rate of the annual adjustment of salaries and pensions. The reinforcement of Item 2 0 0 0 (*Rent*) would allow the Court of Justice to anticipate some payments and create room for manoeuvre in the 2016 budget to cover part of the additional expenditure resulting from the higher than expected annual salary adjustment rate.

- 3. The Budget Committee examined this proposal for a transfer at its meetings on 26 November and 3 December 2015.
- 4. Following that examination, <u>the Budget Committee</u> agreed, by a qualified majority, to suggest that the Permanent Representatives Committee advise the Council to approve:
 - the proposed transfer of appropriations;
 - the draft letter in the ANNEX to that effect.
