Subject:	Proposal for transfer of appropriations No DEC 44/2015 within Section III - Commission - of the general budget for 2015

1. On 2 December 2015, the Commission submitted to the Council proposal for transfer of appropriations No DEC 44/2015.

The purpose of this proposal is to transfer an amount of EUR 15 million in commitment appropriations from Item 19 03 01 04 (*Other crisis management measures and operations*) and EUR 15 million in payment appropriations from Article 40 02 42 (*Emergency Aid Reserve*) to Article 23 02 01 (*Delivery of rapid, effective and needs-based humanitarian aid and food aid*), as recorded in document 14827/15.

2. The transfer is being proposed in order to address the most alarming consequences of the crisis in Yemen, such as displacement and deteriorating nutritional, health and food security conditions of children and the most vulnerable groups.

3. The Budget Committee examined this proposal for a transfer at its meeting on 7 December 2015.
 4. Following that examination, the Budget Committee agreed, by a qualified majority, to suggest that the Permanent Representatives Committee advise the Council to approve:
 - the proposed transfer of appropriations;
 - the draft letter in the ANNEX to that effect.
