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Subject: Request for risk assessment on new psychoactive substances: 25I-NBOMe, AH-7921, MDPV and methoxetamine

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1. In accordance with Article 5 of Council Decision 2005/387/JHA on the information exchange, risk assessment and control of new psychoactive substances, Europol and EMCDDA submitted the Joint Reports on new psychoactive substances: 425I-NBOMe (doc. 17925/13 CORDROGUE 134 SAN 533), AH-7921 (doc. 17926/13 CORDROGUE 135 SAN 534), MDPV (doc. 17927/13 CORDROGUE 136 SAN 535) and methoxetamine (doc. 17928/13 CORDROGUE 137 SAN 536).
2. In conformity with Article 6(1) of Council Decision 2005/387/JHA, the Commission requested that the risk assessments be conducted (doc. 5207/14 CORDROGUE 1 SAN 11). Moreover, a substantial number of Member States also asked for the risk assessments to take place.

3. As a consequence, COREPER is invited to propose that the Council requests that the risks, including the health and social risks, caused by the use of, the manufacture of, and traffic in 425I-NBOMe, AH-7921, MDPV and methoxetamine, the involvement of organised crime and possible consequences of control measures, be assessed in accordance with the procedure set out in paragraphs 2 to 4 of Article 6 of the above-mentioned Council Decision.
  4. Subsequently, the General Secretariat of the Council of the EU is invited to notify this request to the EMCDDA.
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
