(c) Integrity of the Schengen area

The suggestions made by the Presidency regarding the integrity of the Schengen area, which addressed the need for more consultations between Member States before the temporary reintroduction of internal border controls, for better securing external borders, for increasing checks regarding illegal immigration inside the Schengen area and for addressing serious deficiencies in external border controls, were broadly supported. Ministers reconfirmed their commitment to fully apply the procedures for information sharing on temporary

reintroduction of border controls at the internal borders. In particular, in the case of persistent serious deficiencies relating to the external border controls, the Commission should continue to monitor the situation in accordance with the relevant articles of the Schengen Borders Code and propose, where appropriate, the necessary remedies in order to address deficiencies. The Presidency in that regard underlined the urgency in taking the necessary measures regarding the Western Balkan route.
