Subject:	COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATION (EU) No .../. of 21.11.2013 supplementing Regulation (EU) No 168/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council with regard to the vehicle construction and general requirements for the approval of two- or three-wheel vehicles and quadricycles - Intention not to raise objections to a delegated act

1. The Commission has submitted the above delegated act to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and Articles 18(3), 20(2), 21(5), 25(8), 33(6), 57(12) and 65 of Regulation (EU) No 168/2013 on the approval and market surveillance of two- or three-wheel vehicles and quadricycles¹. The Commission having notified the delegated act to the Council on 21 November 2013, the Council could object to it until 21 January 2014.

2. The Working Party on Technical Harmonisation (Motor Vehicles) has examined the delegated act by an electronic information procedure initiated on 10 December 2013 and silently agreed by that there are no grounds for the Council to object to it.

 3. It is therefore suggested that the Permanent Representatives Committee recommend that the Council confirm that it has no intention to object the delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies, that unless the European Parliament objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force on the twentieth day following that of its publication in the Official Journal of the European Union in accordance with Article 24 of the Delegated Regulation.
