The Mission of the Principality of Liechtenstein to the European Union presents its compliments to the General Secretariat of the Council of the European Union and has the honour to refer to the Council's notification of 27 May 2014 and its own notification of 8 July 2014, the latter informing the General Secretariat of the Council of the European Union of the acceptance of the below mentioned legal acts, subject to the fulfilment of constitutional requirements in Liechtenstein in accordance with the second and third sentence of Article 5(2)(a) in combination with Article 5(2)(b) of the Schengen Protocol. In addition, reference is made to the letter from the European Commission's Director General for Migration and Home Affairs, Mr Matthias Ruete, to the Ambassador of the Principality of Liechtenstein to the European Union, dated 3 July 2015¹, concerning, inter alia, the timeline for the notification of the fulfilment of all constitutional requirements for the acceptance of Regulation (EU) No 515/2014 into its internal legal.

In accordance with Article 5(2)(b) of the Schengen Protocol, the Mission of the Principality of Liechtenstein to the European Union has the honour to notify the General Secretariat of the Council of the European Union that the constitutional requirements regarding the following acts have been fulfilled, thereby making the acts binding on Liechtenstein:

- Regulation (EU) No 515/2014 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 16 April 2014 establishing, as part of the Internal Security Fund, the instrument for financial support for external borders and visa and repealing Decision No 574/2007/EC (OJ L 150/143, 20.05.2014);
- Regulation (EU) No 514/2014 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 16 April 2014 laying down general provisions on the Asylum, Migration and Integration Fund and the instrument for financial support for police cooperation, preventing and combating crime and crisis management (OJ L 150/112, 20.05.2014)².

² The Principality of Liechtenstein accepts the content of Regulation (EU) No 514/2014 insofar as it lays down the general rules necessary for the implementation of Regulation (EU) No 515/2014.

The exchange of notes referred to above shall therefore enter into force on the date of this notification.
