Subject: COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATION (EU) .../... of 17.12.2015 supplementing Regulation (EU) No 952/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards transitional rules for certain provisions of the Union Customs Code where the relevant electronic systems are not yet operational and amending Delegated Regulation (EU) 2015/...  
- Intention not to raise objection to a delegated act

---

1. The Commission submitted the above delegated act<sup>1</sup> to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and Regulation (EU) No 952/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council laying down the Union Customs Code<sup>2</sup>, and in particular its Articles 279 and 284(2) thereof. The Commission having notified the delegated act on 17 December 2015, the Council may object to it until 17 February 2016.
2. The Customs Union Working Party was consulted and no delegation considered that there would be grounds for the Council to object to it.

It is therefore suggested that Coreper recommend that the Council confirm that it has no intention to object to the above mentioned delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies that, unless the European Parliament objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force in accordance with Article 284 of Regulation (EU) No 952/2013.
