Subject:	COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATION (EU) .../... of 3.2.2016 determining those operations in connection with the application of agricultural regulations which require the introduction of information into the Custom Information System - Intention not to raise objection to a delegated act

1. The Commission submitted the above delegated act¹ to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and Regulation (EU) No 515/1997 on mutual assistance between the administrative authorities of the Member States and cooperation between the latter and the Commission to ensure the correct application of the law on customs and agricultural matters², and in particular Article 23(4) thereof. The Commission having notified the delegated act on 3 February 2016, the Council may object to it until 3 April 2016.

2. The Customs Union Working Party was consulted and no delegation considered that there would be grounds for the Council to object to it.

 3. It is therefore suggested that Coreper recommend that the Council confirm that it has no intention to object to the above mentioned delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies that, unless the European Parliament objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force in accordance with Article 23(4) of Regulation (EC) No 515/1997.
