Subject: ***Commission delegated decision of 13.1.2016  
amending Annex V to Directive 2005/36/EC of the European  
Parliament and of the Council as regards the evidence of formal  
qualifications and the titles of training courses***

- Intention not to raise objections to a delegated act

---

1. The Commission has submitted the above delegated act<sup>1</sup> to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and Article 21a (4) of Directive 2005/36/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 7 September 2005 on the recognition of professional qualifications.<sup>2</sup> The Commission having notified the delegated act to the Council on 13 January 2016, the Council has until 13 March 2016 to object to it.

2. Delegations have examined the delegated act by written procedure and have concluded by 23 February 2016 that there are no grounds for the Council to object to it.
  3. It is therefore suggested that the Permanent Representatives Committee recommend that the Council confirm that it has no intention to object the delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies, that unless the European Parliament objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force in accordance with Article 21a (4) of Directive 2005/36/EC.
