Supervision measures (Article 8(2) of the Framework Decision)

Where it is the execution state, Estonia only monitors supervision measures as referred to in Article 8(1) of the Framework Decision.

Forwarding to Estonia of a decision on supervision measures with consent of the competent authorities (Article 9(4) of the Framework Decision)

Estonia can accept a decision on supervision measures with the consent of the authorities deciding recognition in the cases referred to in Article (2) of the Framework Decision or where the person to be supervised, has no permanent residence in Estonia. Consent may be given where the person to be supervised has requested that the supervision be organized in Estonia and this is justified on the grounds of the personal circumstances of the person to be supervised or for any other reason.

Languages (Article 24 of the Framework Decision)

Estonia accepts communication in Estonian or English in accordance with the Framework Decision.
