Subject:	Draft Council Implementing Decision setting out a Recommendation on addressing the deficiencies identified in the evaluation of Sweden's application of the Schengen acquis in the field of management of the external borders

1. Following the Council's adoption, in 2013, of Regulation (EU) No 1053/2013 establishing an evaluation and monitoring mechanism to verify the application of the Schengen acquis, a team of experts from the Member States and the Commission carried out an evaluation of Sweden's implementation of the Schengen acquis in the field of management of the external borders in March 2015.
2. In accordance with that Regulation, the Commission submitted to the Council a proposal for a Council Recommendation designed to address the deficiencies identified in the course of the evaluation and to ensure that Sweden applies all Schengen rules related to the management of external borders correctly and effectively.
3. The Working Party for Schengen Matters (Evaluation), including the Mixed Committee partners Norway, Iceland, Switzerland and Liechtenstein, approved the proposal for a Council Recommendation on 4 March 2016 (silence procedure).

4. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore asked to recommend that the Council adopt the draft Council Implementing Decision, as set out in 6686/16, as an 'A' item at a forthcoming meeting.
