
The International Civil Aviation Organisation (ICAO) is holding a High-Level Meeting on a Global Market-Based Measure (GMBM) Scheme on 11-13 May 2016, in Montreal, Canada. The purpose of the meeting is to have a high-level discussion on the draft Assembly Resolution text on a GMBM Scheme and make recommendations to the ICAO Council, in preparation for the 39th Session of the ICAO Assembly.

The European Parliament has taken a keen interest in the activities of the ICAO and, notably, the upcoming meeting of its technical bodies dealing with aviation and environmental matters having a direct impact on EU legislation, and has authorised the sending of a three Member ad hoc delegation to the ICAO High Level Meeting on a GMBM Scheme from 11 to 13 May 2016.

Therefore, I should be grateful if you could facilitate, in accordance with Articles 25 to 27 of the Framework Agreement between the European Parliament and the European Commission, the inclusion of three Members of the European Parliament in the delegation of the European Union, which will participate in the forthcoming meeting as an observer. As part of the established practice, the names of the Members will be forwarded by email by Parliament's Secretariat to its Commission counterpart at least four weeks before the meeting.

A similar letter has been sent to Mr Juncker, President of the European Commission.
