THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to Regulation (EU, Euratom) No 966/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 25 October 2012 on the financial rules applicable to the general budget of the Union and repealing Council Regulation (EC, Euratom) No $1605/2002^1$, and in particular paragraphs 2 and 3 of Article 13 and Articles 169(3) and 178(2) thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) It is necessary to carry over certain appropriations from Section III (Commission) of the 2017 budget to the 2018 budget.
- (2) It is necessary to make certain decommitted appropriations from Section III (Commission) of the 2017 budget available again in the 2018 budget,

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1

The appropriations from Section III (Commission) of the 2017 budget shall be carried over to the 2018 budget as set out in Annexes I, II and III for the reasons set out therein.

Article 2

The decommitted appropriations from Section III (Commission) of the 2017 budget shall be made available again in the 2018 budget as set out in Annex IV for the reasons set out therein.
