#### 'I/A' ITEM NOTE

Subject:	Commission delegated Regulation (EU) .../... of 9.1.2018 supplementing Directive 2014/90/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards the identification of specific items of marine equipment which can benefit from electronic tagging - Intention not to raise objections to the delegated act

---

1. The Commission submitted the above-mentioned delegated act to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and Article 11(3) of Directive 2014/90/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 23 July 2014 on marine equipment and repealing Council Directive 96/98/EC<sup>1</sup>.
2. The Commission notified the delegated act to the Council on 9 January 2018, hence the Council has time until 9 March 2018 to express its objection.
3. On 17 January 2018, the General Secretariat of the Council informed the delegations about this delegated act<sup>2</sup> and requested their reactions<sup>3</sup>, if any, in writing by 7 February 2018.

4. Following the informal written consultation, delegations did not provide any indication that there is any reason to raise objections to the delegated act.
5. In view of the above, it is suggested that the Permanent Representatives Committee invites the Council to confirm that it has no intention to object to the delegated act and inform the Commission and the European Parliament thereof.
6. This implies that, unless the European Parliament objects, the delegated act shall enter into force in accordance with Article 37(5) of Directive 2014/90/EU.
