Subject:	COUNCIL DECISION authorising the opening of negotiations on the conclusion of a Protocol to the Convention on International Interests in Mobile Equipment on Matters specific to Agricultural, Construction and Mining Equipment (MAC Protocol) - Adoption

1. On 23 August 2017, the Commission submitted to the Council a Recommendation for a COUNCIL DECISION authorising the opening of negotiations on the conclusion of a Protocol to the Convention on International Interests in Mobile Equipment on Matters specific to Agricultural, Construction and Mining Equipment (MAC Protocol)¹.
2. The proposal is based on Article 81(2) of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union in conjunction with 218(3) and (4) thereof.
3. The Recommendation was examined by the Working Party on Civil Law Matters (General Questions) at its meeting on 13 September 2017. It was amended in order to correct technical inaccuracies in the Proposal. The revised text was set out in document 12179/17 + ADD 1 RESTREINT.

4. The text was first approved by Coreper on 27 September 2017², before being revised by lawyer linguists. The revised text is set out in document 5109/18.
