THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to Regulation (EU) No 806/2014 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 15 July 2014 establishing uniform rules and a uniform procedure for the resolution of credit institutions and certain investment firms in the framework of a Single Resolution Mechanism and a Single Resolution Fund and amending Regulation (EU) No 1093/2010¹, and in particular Article 56(6) thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the European Commission,

Having regard to the approval by the European Parliament²,

Whereas:

- (1) On 20 December 2017 the Commission, after hearing the Single Resolution Board ('the Board'), in its plenary session, adopted a shortlist of candidates for the position of a member of the Board and provided it to the European Parliament.
- (2) The Council was informed of the shortlist on the same day.
- (3) Pursuant to Article 56(5) of Regulation (EU) No 806/2014, the term of office of full time members of the Board is five years.
- (4) On 14 February 2018, the Commission adopted a proposal for the appointment of Boštjan JAZBEC as a member of the Board and submitted it to the European Parliament for approval,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

Article 1

Mr Boštjan JAZBEC is hereby appointed as a full-time member of the Single Resolution Board for a term of office of five years as from the entry into force of this Decision.

Article 2

This Decision shall enter into force on the date of its publication in the Official Journal of the European Union.
