On 5th December 2017 the Council approved and published the first common EU list of non-cooperative jurisdictions for tax purposes, aimed at promoting good governance criteria globally.

A number of jurisdictions that were part of the scope of the 2017 screening exercise made meaningful commitments at high political level to take the necessary steps to solve the issues identified in their tax policies as concerns. The state of play of the cooperation with the EU with respect to these commitments was set out in Annex II to the 5 December 2017 Council Conclusions.

In line with the comments at the recent ECOFIN meeting and in order to ensure greater transparency and credibility of the EU listing procedure, I invite you as a Chair of the Code of Conduct Group to request permission from those jurisdictions to publish the commitment letters.
