## Committee of the Regions (CoR); Nomination of Mr Matthias Stadler, Bürgermeister, as member of the CoR

Dear Sir,

Article 305 TFEU provides for the Council to appoint members and alternate members of the CoR for five-year terms on the basis of proposals from each Member State. In the event of early termination of the term of office of a member or alternate member, a replacement is appointed for the remainder of the said term of office in accordance with the same procedure.

On 20 September 2017 Dr Heinz SCHADEN resigned from his position as Bürgermeister of the city of Salzburg, thereby also ending his term of office as member of the CoR.

On 21 February 2018 the Austrian Federal Government decided to nominate Mr Matthias STADLER as member of the CoR in his capacity as Bürgermeister of the city of St. Pölten, thereby replacing Dr Heinz SCHADEN.
