Subject:	Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) .../... supplementing Regulation (EU) No 167/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards environmental and propulsion unit performance requirements for agricultural and forestry vehicles and their engines and repealing Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2015/96 - Intention not to raise objections to a delegated act

1. The Commission has submitted the above delegated act to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and with regard to Articles 19(6), 20(8), 28(6) and 53(12) of Regulation (EU) No 167/2013 on the approval and market surveillance of agricultural and forestry vehicles. The Commission having adopted the delegated act on 12 February 2018, the Council may object to it until 12 April 2018.
2. The Working Party on Technical Harmonisation (Motor Vehicles) has examined the delegated act by an electronic information procedure initiated on 13 February 2018 and silently agreed that there are no grounds for the Council to object to it.

3. It is therefore suggested that the Permanent Representatives Committee recommends to the Council to confirm that it has no intention to object to the delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies, that unless the European Parliament objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force in accordance with Regulation (EU) No 167/2013.
