Subject: European Court of Auditors' Special Report No 6/2018: "Free Movement of Workers - the fundamental freedom ensured but better targeting of EU funds would aid worker mobility"

- *Designation of Working Party*

1. On 27 February 2018, the European Court of Auditors published Special Report No 6/2018 entitled "Free Movement of Workers - the fundamental freedom ensured but better targeting of EU funds would aid worker mobility"<sup>1</sup>.
2. Under the rules laid down in the Council conclusions on improving the examination of special reports drawn up by the Court of Auditors<sup>2</sup>, it is suggested that the Permanent Representatives Committee instruct the Working Party on Social Questions to examine the report in accordance with those rules.
