Subject: COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATION (EU) .../... of 16.2.2018
establishing common safety methods for supervision by national safety
authorities after the issue of a single safety certificate or a safety
authorisation pursuant to Directive (EU) 2016/798 of the European
Parliament and of the Council and repealing Commission Regulation (EU)
No 1077/2012

- Intention not to raise objections to the delegated act

1. The Commission submitted the above-mentioned delegated act to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and Article 6(6) of Directive (EU) 2016/798 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 11 May 2016 on railway safety¹.
2. The Commission notified the delegated act to the Council on 16 February 2018, hence the Council may decide until 16 April 2018 to express its objection.
3. On 20 February 2018, the General Secretariat of the Council informed the delegations about this delegated act² and requested their reactions³, if any, in writing by 20 March 2018.

4. Following the informal written consultation, delegations did not provide any indication that there is any reason to raise objections to the delegated act.
5. In view of the above, it is suggested that the Permanent Representatives Committee invites the Council to confirm that it has no intention to object to the delegated act and to inform the Commission and the European Parliament thereof.
6. This implies that, unless the European Parliament objects, the delegated act shall enter into force in accordance with Article 27(6) of Directive (EU) 2016/798.
