Subject: COMMISSION REGULATION (EU) .../... of XXX amending Annexes II and III to Regulation (EC) No 396/2005 of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards maximum residue levels for lambda cyhalothrin in or on certain products
- Decision not to oppose the adoption

1. On 25 April 2018, the Commission submitted for scrutiny by the European Parliament and the Council the above draft Regulation (ST 8352/18 + ADD 1 + ADD 2), in accordance with Article 5 bis (3)(a) of Council Decision 1999/468/EC, as modified by Council Decision No 2006/512/EC laying down the procedures for the exercise of implementing powers conferred on the Commission.
