1. On 27 October 2017, the Commission submitted for scrutiny by the European Parliament and by the Council the above draft Regulation, on the basis of Article 18(5) of Regulation (EU) No 1924/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council¹.
2. The Working Party on Foodstuffs considered, through an informal written procedure², that there are no grounds for the Council to oppose the adoption of the draft Commission Regulation.
