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Subject: COMMISSION REGULATION (EU) .../... of XXX amending Regulation (EC) 1881/2006 as regards maximum levels of glycidyl fatty acid esters in vegetable oils and fats, infant formula, follow-on formula and foods for special medical purposes intended for infants and young children
- *Decision not to oppose adoption*

1. On 8 November 2017, the Commission submitted for scrutiny by the European Parliament and by the Council the above draft Regulation, on the basis of Article 2(3) of Council Regulation (EEC) No 315/93 of the European Parliament and of the Council¹.
2. The Working Party on Foodstuffs considered, through an informal written procedure², that there are no grounds for the Council to oppose the adoption of the draft Commission Regulation.
3. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore invited to:
 - confirm the agreement reached by the Working Party, and
