Subject: Commission delegated Regulation No. (EU) .../.. of 20.10.2017 amending Annexes I, II, VI, VIII and IX to Regulation (EU) No 1007/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council on textile fibre names and related labelling and marking of the fibre composition of textile products  
- Intention not to raise objections to a delegated act

1. The Commission has submitted the above delegated act<sup>1</sup> to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 (2) (b) TFEU and Article 21 (1) of Regulation (EU) No. 1007/2011<sup>2</sup> of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 September 2011 on textile fibre names and related labelling and marking of the fibre composition of textile products and repealing Council Directive 73/44/EEC and Directives 96/73/EC and 2008/121/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council. The Commission, having notified the delegated act to the Council on 20 October 2017, the Council has until 20 December 2017 to object to it.

2. The Working Party on Technical Harmonisation has examined the delegated act by written procedure until 23 November 2017 and has concluded that there are no grounds for the Council to object to it.
  
  3. It is therefore suggested that the Permanent Representatives Committee recommend that the Council confirm that it has no intention to object the delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies, that unless the European Parliament objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force in accordance with Article 21 of Regulation (EU) No 1007/2011.
