Subject: European Court of Auditors' Special Report No 15/2017: "Ex-ante conditionalities and performance reserve in Cohesion: innovative but not yet effective instruments"

- *Designation of Working Party*

1. On 23 November 2017, the European Court of Auditors published Special Report No 15/2017 entitled "Ex-ante conditionalities and performance reserve in Cohesion: innovative but not yet effective instruments"¹.
