- Withdrawal of declaration by the Netherlands

In the light of the notification by the Netherlands regarding the withdrawal of its declaration relating to Council Framework Decision 2008/909/JHA, the following text will be published in the Official Journal of the European Union (L series):

"The Kingdom of the Netherlands has withdrawn its declaration, made in accordance with Article 28(2) of Council Framework Decision 2008/909/JHA of 27 November 2008, on the application of the principle of mutual recognition to judgments in criminal matters imposing custodial sentences or measures involving deprivation of liberty for the purpose of their enforcement in the European Union, as published in the Official Journal of the European Union of 9 October 2009 (L 265/41). This withdrawal has taken effect on 1 June 2018."
