1. Bilateral Agreement on Cooperation between the Republic of Cyprus and the Republic of France on Matters of Internal Security \*

The Bilateral Agreement on Cooperation between the Republic of Cyprus and the Republic of France on Matters of Internal Security was signed on 4 March 2005.

Article 12 of the Agreement provides that it shall enter into force on the first day of the second month after notification by both parties of the completion of their respective internal legal procedures for the ratification of the Agreement.

# RESTREINT UE

The Republic of Cyprus has ratified the Agreement by Ratification Law 49(III)/2005 and has duly notified the Embassy of the Republic of France in Nicosia on the 17<sup>th</sup> January 2006. The Agreement will enter into force, after notification by France as regards the completion of her internal legal procedures.

## 2. French DLO in the Republic of Cyprus

There is a Law enforcement attaché with also Drugs Liaison Officer duties in the Embassy of the Republic of France in Nicosia.
