Subject:	Proposal for transfer of appropriations No DEC 13/2018 within Section III - Commission - of the general budget for 2018

1. On 19 June 2018, the Commission submitted to the Council proposal for transfer of appropriations No DEC 13/2018.

The purpose of this proposal is to transfer an amount of EUR 25 million from Article 40 02 42 (*Emergency aid reserve*) in commitment and payment appropriations to Article 23 02 01 (*Delivery of rapid, effective and needs-based humanitarian aid and food assistance*), as recorded in document 10276/18.

2. The transfer is being proposed in order to provide humanitarian assistance to address the increasing humanitarian needs resulting from the Ebola outbreak and escalating violence in the Democratic Republic of the Congo for an amount of EUR 25 million in both commitment and payment appropriations.

3. The Budget Committee examined this proposal for a transfer at its meeting on 21 June 2018.
 4. Following that examination, the Budget Committee agreed, by a qualified majority, to suggest that the Permanent Representatives Committee advise the Council to approve:
 - the proposed transfer of appropriations;
 - the draft letter in the ANNEX to that effect.
