Subject: COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATION (EU) .../... of 28.5.2018 amending Delegated Regulation (EU) 2015/2195 on supplementing Regulation (EU) No 1304/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the European Social Fund, regarding the definition of standard scales of unit costs and lump sums for reimbursement of expenditure by the Commission to Member States

- Intention not to raise objections to a delegated act

1. The Commission submitted the delegated act in subject¹ to the Council in accordance with Article 290 TFEU and Article 14(1) of Regulation (EU) No 1304/2013². The Commission having notified the delegated act on 28 May 2018, the Council may object to it until 28 July 2018.

2. The Working Party on Structural Measures examined the delegated act in question on 18 June 2018 and agreed that there are no grounds for the Council to object to the delegated act.
3. On 22 June, the Commission adopted a Corrigendum to the Delegated Act³ concerning a non-substantive issue, namely the deletion of the words "and correcting that Delegated Act" at the end of the title.
4. It is therefore suggested that Coreper recommend that the Council confirm that it has no intention to object to the delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies that, unless the European Parliament objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force in accordance with Article 24 of Regulation (EU) No 1304/2013.
