Subject:	COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATION amending Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) No 1042/2014 of 25 July 2014 supplementing Regulation (EU) No 514/2014 of the European Parliament and of the Council with regard to the designation and management and control responsibilities of Responsible Authorities and with regard to status and obligations of Audit Authorities - Intention to extend the period to object

1. The Commission has submitted the above delegated act and its Annex ¹ to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and with Article 58 of Regulation (EU) No 514/2014 of the European Parliament and of the Council laying down general provisions on the Asylum, Migration and Integration Fund and on the instrument for financial support for police cooperation, preventing and combating crime, and crisis management². The Commission having notified the delegated act on 16 May 2018, the Council may object to it until 16 July 2018.

2. The General Secretariat of the Council launched a consultation on the delegated act through the Delegates Portal (silence consultation ending on 26 June 2018), as a result of which two delegations submitted comments in relation to the respective linguistic versions provided by the Commission. The Croatian delegation objected to the delegated act due to serious mistakes found in the Croatian linguistic version.
 3. The Ad hoc Working Party on JHA Financial instruments examined the matter at its meeting on 6 July 2018 and agreed that the period for objection should be extended by two months in order to allow delegations to examine their revised linguistic versions to be provided by the Commission.
 4. It is therefore suggested that Coreper recommends that the Council requests that the period for objection be extended by two months and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof.
