Subject: Proposal for a DIRECTIVE OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL amending Directive 2006/22/EC as regards enforcement requirements and laying down specific rules with respect to Directive 96/71/EC and Directive 2014/67/EU for posting drivers in the road transport sector  
– Outcome of the European Parliament's proceedings (Strasbourg 2 to 5 July 2018)

## I. INTRODUCTION

The rapporteur, Merja KYLLÖNEN (GUE/NGL, FI), presented a report consisting of 104 amendments (amendments 1-104) to the proposal for a Directive on behalf of the Committee on Transport and Tourism.

In addition, the Committee on Employment and Social Affairs tabled thirty seven amendments (amendments 105-141). The political groups tabled the following amendments: EPP tabled four amendments (amendments 156-159), Greens/EFA seven amendments (amendments 142-148), GUE/NGL four amendments (amendments 167-170), ENF four amendments (amendments 161-164). Thirteen amendments were tabled by more than 38 MEPs (amendments 149-155, 165-166 and 171-174).

## II. VOTE

When it voted on 4 July, the plenary adopted amendments 1-69, 72-75, 78-96, 99-104, 113, 128, 139 and 150/1 to the proposal for a Directive. However, the draft legislative act, as amended, was not adopted<sup>1</sup>.

Since the draft legislative act, as amended, failed to secure a majority of the votes cast, the matter was referred back to the Committee for reconsideration, pursuant to Rule 59(4)(4) of the European Parliament's Rules of Procedure, thereby not bringing the Parliament's first reading to a close.
