- *Designation of Working Party*

1. On 29 May 2018, the European Court of Auditors published Special Report No 13/2018 entitled "Tackling radicalisation that leads to terrorism: the Commission addressed the needs of Member States, but with some shortfalls in coordination and evaluation"<sup>1</sup>.
2. Under the rules laid down in the Council conclusions on improving the examination of special reports drawn up by the Court of Auditors<sup>2</sup>, it is suggested that the Permanent Representatives Committee instruct the Working Party on Terrorism to examine the report in accordance with those rules.
