Subject:	Decision of the European Parliament and of the Council on the mobilisation of the European Globalisation Adjustment Fund following an application from the Netherlands – EGF/2018/001 NL/Financial service activities
	– Adoption

- On 20 August 2018, the <u>Commission</u> submitted to the Council a proposal for a Decision of the European Parliament and of the Council on the mobilisation of the European Globalisation Adjustment Fund (EGF), accompanied by the corresponding proposal for transfer of appropriations No DEC 19/2018¹.
- 2. The proposal aims at mobilising an amount of EUR 1 192 500 under the EGF to meet an application from the Netherlands to deploy the Fund in connection with 1 324 workers made redundant in the "Financial service activities, except insurance and pension funding" sector in Friesland, Drenthe and Overijssel. The redundancies are the result of the serious impact that the continuation of the global financial and economic crisis addressed in Regulation (EC) No 546/2009² had on the functioning of Dutch banks, as recorded in document 11657/18.

DECISION OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL on the mobilisation of the European Globalisation Adjustment Fund following an application from the Netherlands – EGF/2018/001 NL/Financial service activities

THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to Regulation (EU) No 1309/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 17 December 2013 on the European Globalisation Adjustment Fund (2014-2020) and repealing Regulation (EC) No 1927/2006¹, and in particular Article 15(4) thereof,

Having regard to the Interinstitutional Agreement of 2 December 2013 between the European Parliament, the Council and the Commission on budgetary discipline, on cooperation in budgetary matters and on sound financial management², and in particular Point 13 thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the European Commission,

Whereas:

- (1) The European Globalisation Adjustment Fund (EGF) aims to provide support for workers made redundant and self-employed persons whose activity has ceased as a result of major structural changes in world trade patterns due to globalisation, as a result of a continuation of the global financial and economic crisis, or as a result of a new global financial and economic crisis, and to assist them with their reintegration into the labour market.
- (2) The EGF is not to exceed a maximum annual amount of EUR 150 million (2011 prices), as laid down in Article 12 of Council Regulation (EU, Euratom) No 1311/2013³.

respect of redundancies in 20 enterprises operating in the Financial services sector in the

following regions: Friesland, Drenthe and Overijssel in the Netherlands. It was

supplemented by additional information provided in accordance with Article 8(3) of

Regulation (EU) No 1309/2013. That application complies with the requirements for

determining a financial contribution from the EGF as laid down in Article 13 of Regulation
