Subject:	Transfer of appropriations No DEC 21/2018 within Section III - Commission - of the general budget for 2018 – <i>Approval</i>

1. The Commission submitted to the Council proposal for transfer of appropriations No DEC 21/2018 related to the mobilisation of the European Globalisation Adjustment Fund (EGF) following an application from Portugal (EGF/2018/002 PT/Norte-Centro-Lisboa wearing apparel)¹.
2. The purpose of this transfer is to move an amount of EUR 4 655 883 in commitment appropriations from Article 40 02 43 (*Reserve for the European Globalisation Adjustment Fund*) to Article 04 04 01 (*EGF- to support workers and self-employed persons whose activity has ceased as a result of globalisation*), as recorded in document 12030/18.
