I. INTRODUCTION

- The <u>Commission</u> submitted to the <u>Council</u> on 17 September 2018 the above-mentioned proposal for a Council Decision on the Union position at the <u>European Committee for</u> <u>drawing up Standards in the field of Inland Navigation</u> (CESNI) and in the <u>Central</u> <u>Commission for the Navigation of the Rhine (CCNR)</u>.
- 2. <u>CESNI</u> will convene in Prague, Czechia, on 8 November 2018. The date of <u>CCNR</u> meeting deciding on this matter is not known yet.
- 3. The <u>Union</u> is not a contracting party to CESNI, but all <u>Member States</u> may participate and vote in CESNI meetings. The Union is not a contracting party to CCNR, either. <u>Belgium</u>, <u>France</u>, <u>Germany</u> and the <u>Netherlands</u>, in addition to <u>Switzerland</u>, are the contracting parties to CCNR.

II. WORK AT THE PREPARATORY BODY

4. The <u>Shipping Working Party</u> examined the proposal and endorsed the draft as presented by the Commission on 25 September 2018.

III. CONCLUSIONS

- The <u>Permanent Representatives Committee</u> is invited to endorse the draft Decision and to submit for adoption by the <u>Council</u> (ECOFIN) on 6 November 2018, as presented in document 12437/18 and revised by the lawyer-linguists.
- 6. The <u>Council</u> is invited to adopt the Decision.
- 7. Once adopted, the <u>European Parliament</u> will be informed about the Council Decision.
