## CORRIGENDUM

### **to Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) .../... of 12 July 2018 amending Implementing Regulation (EU) No 543/2011 as regards marketing standards in the fruit and vegetables sector**

In the Annex replacing Annex I to Implementing Regulation (EU) No 543/2011, in Section II.B of Part 3 of Part B:

*for:* 'B. Minimum maturity requirements

The kiwifruit must be sufficiently developed and display satisfactory ripeness.

In order to satisfy this requirement, the fruit at packing must have attained a degree of ripeness of at least 6.2° Brix<sup>21</sup> or an average dry matter content of 15%, which should lead to 9.5° Brix<sup>18</sup> when entering the distribution chain',

*read:* 'B. Minimum maturity requirements

The kiwifruit must be sufficiently developed and display satisfactory ripeness.

In order to satisfy this requirement, the fruit at packing must have attained a degree of ripeness of at least 6.2° Brix<sup>21</sup> or an average dry matter content of 15%, which should lead to 9.5° Brix<sup>21</sup> when entering the distribution chain'.
