- *Designation of Working Party*

1. On 23 October 2018, the European Court of Auditors published Special Report No 24/2018 entitled "Demonstrating carbon capture and storage and innovative renewables at commercial scale in the EU: intended progress not achieved in the past decade"<sup>1</sup>.
2. Under the rules laid down in the Council conclusions on improving the examination of special reports drawn up by the Court of Auditors<sup>2</sup>, it is suggested that the Permanent Representatives Committee instruct the Working Party on the Environment to examine the report in accordance with those rules.
