Subject:	Transfer of appropriations No DEC 31/2018 within Section III - Commission - of the general budget for 2018

1. On 29 October 2018, the Commission submitted to the Council proposal for transfer of appropriations No DEC 31/2018.

The purpose of this proposal is to transfer an amount of EUR 15 million in commitment appropriations (c/a) from Article 40 02 42 (*Emergency aid reserve*) to Article 23 02 01 (*Delivery of rapid, effective and needs-based humanitarian aid and food assistance*), as recorded in document 13692/18.

2. The transfer is being proposed in order to respond to urgent and acute needs of the most vulnerable populations (refugees and host communities) in Uganda and to mitigate tensions between them for an amount of EUR 15 million in c/a.

3. The Budget Committee examined this proposal for a transfer at its meeting on 31 October 2018.
4. Following that examination, the Budget Committee agreed, by a qualified majority, to suggest that the Permanent Representatives Committee advise the Council to approve:
 - the proposed transfer of appropriations;
 - the draft letter in the ANNEX to that effect.
