**'I/A' ITEM NOTE**

From: General Secretariat of the Council  
To: Permanent Representatives Committee/Council  
Subject: a) Council Decision on the signing, on behalf of the European Union, of the Agreement between the European Union and the Federative Republic of Brazil amending the Agreement between the European Union and the Federative Republic of Brazil on short-stay visa waiver for holders of ordinary passports  
– Adoption  
b) Council Decision on the conclusion of the same Agreement  
– Request for the consent of the European Parliament

1. On 11 April 2018, the Commission submitted a proposal for a Council Decision on the signing, on behalf of the European Union, of the Agreement between the European Union and the Federative Republic of Brazil amending the Agreement between the European Union and the Federative Republic of Brazil on short-stay visa waiver for holders of ordinary passports<sup>1</sup>, together with a draft text of the said agreement in the annex to that proposal<sup>2</sup>, and a proposal for a Council Decision on the conclusion of the same agreement<sup>3</sup>.

2. On 22 October 2018, the Visa Working Party agreed on these proposals. On the same occasion, the Visa Working Party also approved a declaration to be annexed to the decision on the signing, concerning the entry into force of Regulation 2017/2226 establishing the Entry/Exit System (EES) and the Member States applying the Schengen *acquis* in full<sup>4</sup>.
3. The Decision on the signing of the abovementioned agreement constitutes a development of the provisions of the Schengen *acquis* in which the United Kingdom does not take part, in accordance with Council Decision 2000/365/EC of 29 May 2000; the United Kingdom is therefore not taking part in their adoption and is not bound by them or subject to their application.
4. The Decision on the signing constitutes a development of the provisions of the Schengen *acquis* in which Ireland does not take part, in accordance with Council Decision 2002/192/EC of 28 February 2002; Ireland is therefore not taking part in their adoption and is not bound by them or subject to their application.
5. The Decision on the signing and the text of the agreement have been edited by the legal-linguistic experts. They are set out in respectively 13447/18 VISA 280 COLAC 86 and 13449/18 VISA 282 COLAC 88.

The Decision on the conclusion of the same agreement has also been edited by the legal-linguistic experts. The edited text is set out in 13448/18 VISA 281 COLAC 87.

6. The Permanent Representatives Committee is accordingly invited to recommend that the Council:
  - a) adopt, as an "A" item of the agenda of one of its forthcoming sessions, the Decision on the signing as set out in 13447/18;
  - b) decide to forward the draft Decision on the conclusion as set out in 13448/18 to the European Parliament for its consent once the agreement has been duly signed.

The Decision on the signing will be published in the OJ in accordance with the applicable rules.
