Subject: Outcome of the Working Party on Fundamental Rights, Citizens' Rights
and Free Movement of Persons (FREMP)

1. Accession of the European Union to the European Convention for the Protection of Human Rights and Fundamental Freedoms

Following the Commission's presentation of its technical contribution on the judicial review of acts on the part of the EU in CFSP matters on 19 October, delegations reverted to the discussion of the paper. During the exchange of views, several delegations welcomed the ideas put forward in the Commission technical contribution. Delegations also stressed the need to guarantee a sufficient level of human rights protection. The Commission was asked by several delegations to provide the Working Party with a comprehensive document summarising previous discussions and a revised version of the draft accession agreement.

2. Proposal for a Directive of the European Parliament and of the Council on the protection of persons reporting on breaches of Union law

The Working Party finished the examination of the Presidency revised text set out in doc. 12998/18 and preliminarily discussed additional drafting suggestions in WK 13940/2018 and WK 13889/2018.

3. AOB

The Presidency provided information about the draft Council Declaration on the fight against antisemitism and the development of a common security approach to better protect Jewish communities and institutions in Europe being discussed in the Coordinating Committee in the area of police and judicial cooperation in criminal matters (CATS).
