Subject: Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council establishing the EU Anti-Fraud Programme (**first reading**)
– *Partial mandate for negotiations with the European Parliament*

1. On 30 May 2018, the Commission transmitted the above mentioned proposal which is part of the package submitted in the context of the multiannual financial framework 2021-2027.
2. This proposal is based on Articles 33 and 325 TFEU.
3. The European Court of Auditors adopted its opinion on 15 November 2018¹.
4. The Working Party on Combating Fraud examined the Commission proposal at its meetings on 11 June, 13 September, 29 October, 29 November and 12 December 2018 and was able to agree on the text in the Addendum to this note as a basis for negotiations with the European Parliament.
