Subject:	Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) .../... of 28.11.2018 amending Delegated Regulation (EU) No. 1062/2014 as regards certain active substances/product-type combinations for which the competent authority of the United Kingdom has been designated as the evaluating competent authority - Intention not raise objection to a delegated act

1. The Commission has submitted the above delegated act¹ to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and in particular first subparagraph of Article 89(1) of Regulation (EU) No 528/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 22 May 2012 concerning the making available on the market and use of biocidal products². The Commission having notified the delegated act on 28 November 2018, the Council may object to it until 28 January 2019.

2. The Working Party on Environment has examined the delegated act through an informal written procedure and agreed that there are no grounds for the Council to object it.

 3. It is therefore suggested that Coreper recommends that the Council confirms that it has no intention to object to the delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies that, unless the European Parliament objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force on the twentieth day following its publication in the Official Journal of the European Union in accordance with Article 2 of the Delegated Regulation.
