Subject: COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATION (EU) .../... of 19.12.2018 amending Delegated Regulation (EU) 2015/2446 as regards the time-limits for lodging entry summary declarations and pre-departure declarations in case of transport by sea from and to the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, the Channel Islands and the Isle of Man
- Intention not to raise objections

1. On 19 December 2018, the Commission has submitted the above delegated act to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and Article 284(5) of Regulation (EU) No 952/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council laying down the Union Customs Code¹ (UCC). The Commission having notified the delegated act on 19 December 2018, the Council may object to it until 19 February 2019.
2. The Working Party on Customs Union has examined the delegated act and agreed that there are no grounds for the Council to object to it.

3. It is therefore suggested that Coreper recommend that the Council confirm that it has no intention to object to the delegated act, and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies that, unless the European Parliament objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force in accordance with Article 284(5) of the UCC.
