Subject: Commission Regulation (EU) .../.... of xx.xx. amending Annex VI to Regulation (EC) No 1223/2009 of the European Parliament and of the Council on cosmetic products
- Decision not to oppose adoption

1. Article 31(2) of Regulation (EC) No 1223/2009 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 30 November 2009 on cosmetic products¹ provides for a procedure to amend the annexes II to VI of this Regulation.
2. Therefore, in accordance with Article 5a(2) of Council Decision 1999/468/EC², the Committee established under Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 was consulted on 10 December 2018. It voted with 27 delegations in favour of the above draft Regulation.³
3. Consequently, the Commission submitted the above draft Regulation⁴ to the Council on 8 January 2019, in accordance with Article 5a(3)(a) of Council Decision 1999/468/EC.

4. Under the regulatory procedure with scrutiny, the Council, acting by qualified majority, may oppose the Commission's adoption of the draft Commission Regulations on the grounds that the draft measures presented by the Commission:
 - exceed the implementing powers provided for in the basic instrument, or
 - are not compatible with the aim or the content of the basic instrument, or
 - do not respect the principles of subsidiarity or proportionality.
 5. The delegations were asked on 11 January 2019 to indicate their possible opposition to the draft Regulation before 11 February 2019. No delegation raised any of the above-mentioned grounds for opposition.
 6. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore invited to recommend to the Council to confirm, as an "A" item of its agenda, that it is not opposed to the draft Regulation in subject.
