Nomination of Mr Markus Achleitner, Landesrat, as member of the Committee of the **Regions** 

Pursuant to Article 305 TFEU, the Council appoints members and alternate members of the CoR for five years on the basis of a proposal made by each Member State. Where the term of office of a member or an alternate member is terminated before expiry of that period, a replacement is appointed for the remaining term of office by the same procedure.

Dr Michael STRUGL, MBA, left the Government of the Province of Upper Austria on 6 December 2018, thereby also ending his term of office as member of the CoR.

On 11 January 2019, the Austrian Federal Government therefore decided to nominate Mr Markus ACHLEITNER, Landesrat, to replace Dr Michael STRUGL MBA as member of the CoR
