# THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION,

Having regard to Regulation (EU) No 492/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 5 April 2011 on freedom of movement for workers within the Union<sup>2</sup>, and in particular Articles 23 and 24 thereof.

Whereas:

- In its Decisions of 28 September 2018<sup>3</sup>, 15 October 2018<sup>4</sup>, 19 November 2018<sup>5</sup> and 18 February 2019<sup>6</sup>, the Council appointed the members and alternate members of the Advisory Committee on Freedom of Movement for Workers for the period ending on 24 September 2020.
- (2) A seat as member in the governments' representatives category has fallen vacant as a result of the resignation of Ms Eszter ENYEDI.
- (3) The Government of Hungary has submitted a nomination for the vacant seat,
