Subject:	COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATION (EU) .../... of 15.2.2019 supplementing Regulation (EU) No 1303/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council with regard to the form of financing which is not linked to costs of the relevant operations - Intention not to raise objections to a delegated act

1. The Commission submitted the delegated act in subject<sup>1</sup> to the Council in accordance with Article 149(4) of Regulation (EU) No 1303/2013<sup>2</sup>. The Commission having notified the delegated act on 15 February 2019, the Council may object to it until 15 April 2019.

2. The Working Party on Structural Measures examined the delegated act in question on 1 March 2019 and agreed that there were no grounds for the Council to object to the delegated act.
  3. The Permanent Representatives Committee is, therefore, invited to recommend to the Council, at one of its future meetings, to confirm that it has no intention to object to the delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies that, unless the European Parliament objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force in accordance with Article 149(5) of Regulation (EU) No 1303/2013.
