1. Draft Council conclusions: other uses of nuclear technologies than for electricity production

Member States confirmed their support for Council conclusions on this topic and showed interest in the possibility of enlarging the scope of the current text.

Member States were invited to submit their written comments by 22 March, close of business.

2. Any other business

- FI delegation informed the Member States about the granting of a licence to a new power plant that will help the country to reduce electricity import;

- CZ delegation reminded that the registration for the European Nuclear Energy Forum (ENEF) is open until 14 April and invited the Member States to participate;

- BG delegation informed the Member States about the finalisation of the report on the Integrated Review Service for Radioactive Waste and Spent Fuel Management, Decommissioning and Remediation (ARTEMIS) mission that was conducted in Bulgaria in June 2018;

- EE delegation informed the Member States about the conclusion of the Integrated Regulatory Review Service (IRRS) mission held at the beginning of March;

- DE delegation (echoed by FR and BE) reiterated its question regarding the enforcement of rules and procedures in the context of the Euratom Supply Agency.
