Subject: Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) .../... of 26.2.2019 supplementing Directive 2003/87/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council with regard to the operation of the Innovation Fund
- Intention not to raise objection to a delegated act

1. The Commission has submitted the above delegated act¹ to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and in particular Article 10a(8) of Directive 2003/87/EC establishing a system for greenhouse gas emission allowance trading within the Union and amending Council Directive 96/61/EC². The Commission having notified the delegated act on 26 February 2019, the Council may object to it until 26 April 2019.

2. The Working Party on Environment has examined the delegated act through an informal written procedure and agreed that there are no grounds for the Council to object it.

 3. It is therefore suggested that Coreper recommends that the Council confirms that it has no intention to object to the delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies that, unless the European Parliament objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force on the twentieth day following its publication in the Official Journal of the European Union in accordance with Article 28 of the Delegated Regulation.
